

Itinerary of the Calédonien Sydney–Marseilles, April–May 1970.

Taken from diary notes on the voyage.

- April 3 Depart Sydney 1100
- 5 Quiller Memorandum shown
- 6 Arrive Noumea
- 7 Depart Noumea
- 8 Arrive Santo: very hot. Mayo's place in the evening.
- 9 Barbecue organized by ship at beach. Very hot.
- 12 Depart Santo 0600
Arrive Port Vila (time uncertain)
- 15 Depart Port Vila
- 20 Arrive Papeete 1200. Into town, hired Fiat 124 wagon.
Gauguin Museum, night drive.
- 21 Completely circumnavigated island. Visited Point Venus in evening.
- 22 Depart Papeete for Taiohae 1200 – market, shopping. Returned car to Tahiti Express in morning.
- 25 Arrive Taiohae. Feast at 8.30pm.
- 26 Depart Taiohae 0500.
- May 5 Arrive Balboa 1800. Shopping.
- 6 Depart Balboa, 0600, entered Panama Canal.
Depart Cristobal, 1400, leaving Panama Canal.
- 9 Arrive Martinique 0700.
- 10 Visit to St Pierre (site of volcanic eruption) and Fort-de-France.
Depart Martinique.
- 14 Picked up Radio Luxembourg – almost there!
- 15 Party – dancing, games and stale sandwiches.
- 17 2 movies shown
- 18 Arrive Funchal, Madeira 0700. Walk to Lido and back. Bus to Câmara de Lobos and back. Shopping in Funchal. Returned to ship 1330.
Depart Funchal 1600.
- 20 Straits of Gibraltar 0900.
- 22 Arrived Marseilles, a.m., train to Paris 1200.
